What is an Outdoor Activity Instructor?

The main responsibility of an Outdoor Activity Instructor is to run a safe and enjoyable outdoor activity session, guiding and supporting both children and adults in a variety of activities and pastimes.

They will:

- **Prepare the session** – gather information about the participants and resources for the activity.
- **Deliver the session** – brief participants, maintain safety, provide on-going instruction and encouragement.
- **Meet session outcome** – support participants to achieve set outcome (such as new skills / knowledge, thrill seeking, personal or team challenge).
- **Close the session** – hand-over participants, return resources and equipment, log any issues.

Production of a portfolio of evidence

GATEWAY (TYPICALLY 1 MONTH)

Achieved English and Maths Level 2
Complied portfolio of evidence



END-POINT ASSESSMENT (MAXIMUM 2 MONTHS)

Practical Test: session template and questions + observation and questions
Professional discussion guided by portfolio of evidence

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Employers will have their own specific entry requirements but could include the following:

- Level 2 Award in Functional Skills English or equivalent
- Level 2 Award in Functional Skills Mathematics or equivalent
- 18 years or above or at the employer's discretion due to the nature of the work
- Existing skills and knowledge of Outdoor Activity
